In late 2017 Catherine applied for an artist residency on Fogo Island, NFLD and a soon discovered that roughly 900 artists worldwide had also applied for this very coveted residency so she decided that a back up plan was in order. Therefore, she applied for the Self-Directed two-week artist residency at Artscape Gibraltar Point on Toronto Island; she figured it was still an island and could be an excellent back up plan. Once accepted she invited Karen to apply too with the idea that they would share a studio space and be inspired by each other's energy. Karen applied for a one-week residency and was also accepted.

Artscape Gibraltar Point's Self-Directed Residencies offer short-term studio and overnight accommodations for creative types wanting to focus on their work without the day to day distractions of home. Artscape hosts writers, musicians, dancers, artists along with folks needing a distraction-free environment for individual research, collaborative projects, people who just need quiet time to reach a deadline or those requiring a large temporary workspace.
