Many of us have been captivated by the work of John Ceprano, whose rock sculptures at Remic Rapids has provided Ottawa with a unique area of beauty and contemplation.

The mandate and goals of Ottawa Rock Art include:

- a) providing an installation of temporal "BALANCED NATURAL ROCK SCULPTURES" in the Ottawa River at Remic Rapids Park, Ottawa;
- b) organizing and choreographing 'on site' artistic performances & events (including OTTAWA BAWI) throughout the season;
- c) providing workshops for educational institutions, teaching "THE ART OF BALANCE"
- d) promoting the natural culture, heritage of the region which encourages a "green city" lifestyle
