Kate Ryckman: artist, teacher, creative explorer

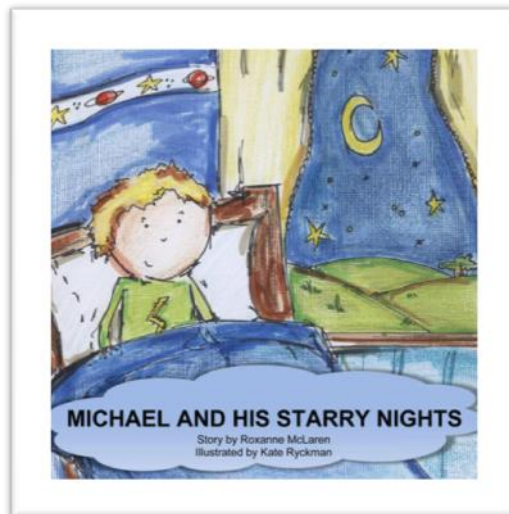
