Paula will be sharing a chronological series of her works, along with the various inspirations behind her work.

Paula Zoubek has an extensive history of teaching, showing and selling her art since the 1960's. She has been awarded both a Canada Council Grant and an Ontario Arts Council Grant. She has also acted as a curator and/or curatorial assistant for a variety of venues, including the Royal Ontario Museum in Toronto.

Her website gives prominence to a quote by Lord Alfred Tennyson "I am a part of all that I have met" and then continues with an artistic statement that embodies Paula's philosophy and approach to her work, along with her commitment to the growth of art and its impact on the human condition.

"The history of civilization is rich and despite countless setbacks encountered by humanity, we are still surrounded by beautiful art and artifacts. I am celebrating these in my paintings, and I am also celebrating nature that is indomitable. In its regeneration, it brings us joy and colour, no matter what is perpetrated on it by humanity.
